The A. O. C. Nier Undergraduate Scholarship in Physics (\$8,000).

This scholarship has been endowed by Mr. Albert Nerkin to honor his friend and professional associate, Professor Alfred O. C. Nier. Applicants must be sophomore physics majors who have completed at least 15 credits in physics.

Harry and Viola St. Cyr Scholarship for Summer Research (\$6,000).

The Harry and Viola St. Cyr scholarship was established by Professor Phyllis Freier in honor of her parents. The scholarship provides \$6,000 for a student to work for 10 weeks in a research laboratory in the School of Physics and Astronomy during the summer, 2008. Applicants must be physics or astrophysics majors currently in their freshman or sophomore years. Attach a research plan to include areas of research interests and proposed research advisers.

Edmond G. Franklin Scholarships (= 1 year tuition)
